

**JAPANESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2010**

The Japanese Government offers scholarships to foreign students who wish to study at Japanese universities undergraduate students.

**1. FIELDS OF STUDY****1) Social Sciences and Humanities**

**Social Sciences and Humanities – A:** Law, Politics, Pedagogy, Sociology, Literature, History, Japanese Language and other  
**Social Sciences and Humanities – B:** Economics and Business Administration.

•It is difficult for applicants who wish to major in the fields categorized as 'others'

**2) Natural Sciences****Natural Sciences – A:**

Science (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry), Electric & Electronics Studies (Electronics, Electrical Engineering, Information Engineering), Mechanical Studies (Mechanical Engineering, Naval Architecture), Civil Engineering and Architecture (Civil Engineering, Architecture, Environmental Engineering), Chemical Studies (Applied Chemistry, Chemical Engineering, Industrial Chemistry, Textile Engineering) and other fields (Metallurgical Engineering, Mining Engineering, Maritime Engineering and Biotechnology).

**Natural Sciences – B:**

Agricultural Studies (Agriculture, Agricultural Chemistry, Agricultural Engineering, Animal Science, Veterinary Medicine, Forestry, Food Science, Fisheries), Hygienic Studies (Pharmacy, Hygienics, Nursing) and Science (Biology).

**Natural Sciences – C: Medicine and Dentistry****2. QUALIFICATIONS**

- 1) Nationality: Indian
- 2) Age: 17-21 as of April 1, 2010 (i.e. born on between April 2, 1988 and April 1, 1993)
- 3) Academic Background: Applicants must have completed a twelve year regular course of school education with minimum of 65% marks in aggregate (Those who will satisfy the above qualifications by March 2010 may apply).
- 4) Japanese Language: Applicants must (be willing to) learn the Japanese language and (to) receive university education in the Japanese language.

**3. TERM OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The awards are tenable for five years from April 2010 to March 2015 including the preliminary instruction in the Japanese language and other subjects (one-year course) given immediately after the arrival in Japan, except for those majoring in Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Medicine, whose term of scholarship is seven years until March 2017.

**4. SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS**

Allowance: 1,25,000 yen (approx. Rs. 60,000) per month (This may be subject to change)
